Tanta University Sends Convoy No. 54 to Al-Mahalla Al-Kobra on Saturday, November 23, 2019

The convoy was inaugurated in attendance of 26 doctors of academic staff from Faculty of Medicine as well as many academic staff members from Faculty of Pharmacy to supervise distributing medicaments that cost 70 thousand pounds. Sedico Pharmaceutical Company provided most of the medicaments that were distributed to patients for free. During the convoy, 1273 patients were examined and 14 cases were transferred to University Hospital to be checked and continue treatment for free.
