A Convoy to Segin Village and Adjacent Villages and Hamlets in Kotor District in September 2019

The convoy was inaugurated in attendance of 22 doctors of academic staff from Faculty of Medicine as well as assistant staff members from Faculty of Pharmacy to supervise distributing medicaments that cost 65 thousand pounds. The medicaments were disbursed for free to 1687 patients who visited the convoy to be examined. Eight cases were transferred to University Hospital to be checked and continue treatment for free.
